The purpose of the Alumni Hall of Fame is to recognize and honor Bowie State University Alumni and other persons who have made significant contributions to society and brought credit to Bowie State University and or its students.

A non-alumnus may be inducted into the Hall of Fame in recognition of significant contributions to Bowie State University through philanthropy and/or intellectual contributions.

* Honorees are required to purchase a ticket to attend the Gala and must be present to accept the award. Each honoree will receive a Hall of Fame award bearing the official insignia, and their portrait will be featured on the BSUNAA website.

Outstanding individuals may be inducted each year from each of the following categories:

Arts & Entertainment	Community Service	Medicine	Religion
Business	Education	Military	Science
Communication	Government and Law	Philanthropy	

CRITERIA:

- A. Achievements that have strengthened Bowie State University and advanced its purpose, and
- B. Achievements that have enhanced the nominee's reputation on a local, regional, national, or international level, and
- C. Achievements that have contributed to public appreciation of Bowie State University.

ELIGIBILITY:

Eligible nominees include Bowie State University alumni; former or current faculty and administrators; graduates and non-graduates; and other individuals who, through service and/or philanthropy, have made significant contributions to the University.

Public announcements will be made prior to the induction ceremony.

Note: The Alumni Hall of Fame is separate from the BSUNAA Sports Hall of Fame.

Nominations should include the nominee's name, address, phone number, photograph, a brief biological sketch, and a concise description of the achievements on which the nomination is based.
